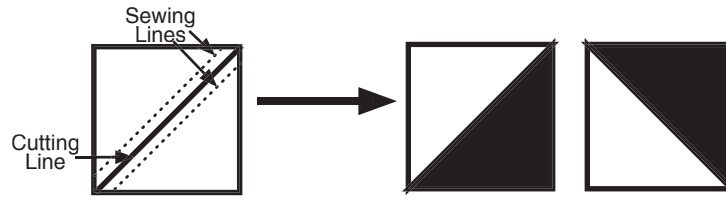


Half Square Triangles (HST)

Our method makes the HSTs a little larger than required. They are then trimmed to exact size.

Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the lighter colored squares. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of drawn line. Cut the squares on the drawn line. Press seams toward the darker fabric.



Use your cutting template to trim to an exact final size (including seam allowance.) Use the 45° line on the ruler for a perfect cut. Each pair of squares will yield two HSTs.

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
